Acquisition Price Update using AAC IMPORT ENTRIES FROM AAC FILE menu option


This menu option allows users to upload an acquisition price update from McKesson that will automatically update the Price Per Order Unit field in the drug file. It is advisable to update Acquisition Price monthly after the monthly Benchmark Price update patch (APSA) is installed.

- 1. First you will need to contact James Quinton james.quinton@mckesson.com with McKesson and let him know your McKesson account number, account name, and SMO User ID. McKesson will then enable your account to create a report called RPSM Extract.
- 2. Login to McKesson Connect website and click on Reports under the Ordering/Inventory tab (not under the Pharmacy Management/Programs reports menu) and choose Cost Change Report.




3. You may choose to retrieve full load (all prices) or for a specified date range up to 6 months in the past. Full load may take a little longer to download, but will have all prices for your account.


Choose full load or set your preferred date range. Click the radio button for RPMS Extract and accept all defaults. Click Generate Report at the bottom.




4. If necessary, click the yellow bar in Internet Explorer to allow the file to download. Click the Save button to save the file onto your computer where you can find it. (If Save does not work, use Open to open the file in Excel and then save it to your computer.) The file will be a .csv delimited file. Do not change the file type.



5. Save the file onto your computer where you can find it. Click Yes if you get a prompt about compatibility with this format.





- 6. Ask your site manager to put the file on the RPMS server (e.g., in the Pub directory). Or copy the file into this directory if you have access to do so. You will also need to know the exact name of the path where the file is located on the server (ask your site manager) in order to run the automatic update.
- 7. Go to the PIHS IHS-Specific Pharmacy Options menu.

Select AAC Import Entries from AAC file.

ENTER THE DEVICE TO PRINT THE ERROR LIST – This is a listing of drugs that couldn't be matched. You'll get a list of drug names that couldn't be matched for AAC updating when you run the AWP Manual Update. You'll need to check the Price per Order Unit for those drugs periodically to make sure that it has the correct current acquisition cost.

8. Run the Benchmark Price Manual Update option to move the cost information from the AWP Med Transaction file into the Drug File. If you do not run Benchmark Price Manual Update, the Drug file will not be updated with new prices.

If you have separate McKesson accounts at your facility (ie for Outpatient and Inpatient) you may want to load an acquisition price update for each account since the drugs included in each account may be different.
